
Although there have been no mentions or Golden Table this week, we would like to say how extremely proud we are of all the children for taking the change in weather in their stride and for moving around the site sensibly.



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Y3 - This week in our vehicle lessons (Around Europe in 80 days) the focus has been Geography. We have learnt about the location of the equator, the Arctic and Antarctic circles and Eastern and Western Europe. Map work can be very tricky, so recapping this knowledge is always useful. Have a look on Google Maps with your child to explore this further.



This week Year 4 have been studying Mexican artist Frida Kahlo who is remembered for her self-portraits and bold, vibrant colours.











KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

On Monday, Year 2 had an exciting visit from Hucknall Fire Station. First, we learned about The Great Fire of London. We shared our knowledge about how the fire started and how it spread. Then, we talked about fire safety. Finally, we went outside to see their fire engine. The children were able to go inside the fire engine and squirt the hose. Miss Wragg even tried on the uniform!







KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Year 5 have started a new unit of work in English this week. This is based on the true story of Phillipe Petit, who walked on a tight rope between The Twin Towers in the 1974. The text is called 'The Man Who Walked Between The Towers.' and the children in year 5 have loved hearing about his story and seeing some real images of the walk. Also, in reading this week, we have been learning about tsunamis, how these are caused and the devasting impact these can have. We have read a fact file all about tsunamis and have then completed a variety of tasks about this.

This week Year 6 has been battling the complexities of algebra, formula and equations in maths. Our brains have been fried. The children have been brilliant working on SATs style questions. Who remembers X equals 5 when they were at school? Hands up please.
