The **Nursery** children have been very creative this week exploring our new materials in our loose parts area.




F2 have had a very busy week this week. We have been working hard on our reading and writing this week and have been learning all about the 'igh' phoneme. The children have been amazing with their reading and their writing and all of the F2 staff have been blown away with the progress that they have been making. The children have been visiting Mrs Sheridan's office and receiving prizes from her prize box. In our vehicle lesson we have been designing our carnival floats and are designing our own class float ready for our carnival.

We have seen some amazing designs for our headdresses so far. We were lucky enough this week to watch the Rocksteady Performance which the children were able to link the live music to the carnival. We have also been working hard in our PE lessons working on team work and large movement. The children used the parachute in a variety of games.



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have started a new text in English this week; Hansel and Gretel, a dark, thrilling fairy tale by Neil Gaiman. Story telling is a fabulous skill that can hold the audience in the moment and this is exactly what this text did. Despite the children knowing the tale and making good predictions, they were surprised and shocked in parts of the story. I hope their alternative endings will be just as thrilling!



Year 4 have been working really hard on Frida Kahlo biographies this week. They wrote their own at the end of a three-week unit, using their knowledge from our art lessons and guided reading which focused on her. This meant the children were bursting with facts! Some of the outcomes were amazing and really showed off their knowledge and skills. Well done Year 4!

Year 1 have enjoyed learning all about animals this week and animal classification. They have also worked practically on division calculations.



Year 2 have been learning about the Artist Stephen Wiltshire this week in Art. He was diagnosed with Autism when he was 3 years old and is famous for sketching cities.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)


