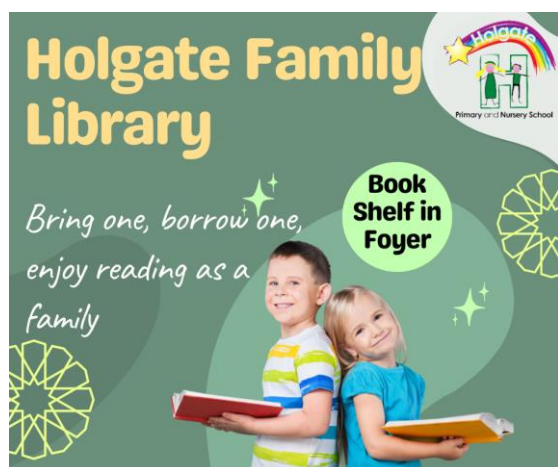

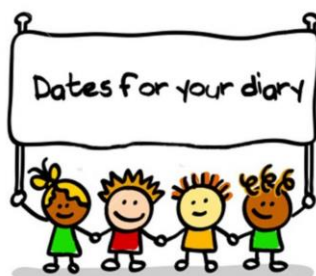

Nursery had a great time with Fudge and Co when they came to visit, we were really brave and held lots of different minibeasts. Did you know a giant millipede has 150 legs!

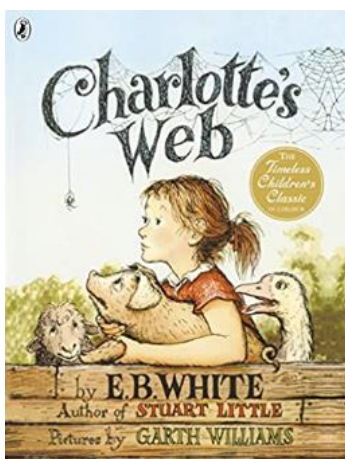

Last week in **Year 3's** reading lessons we were looking at retrieval – pulling the information from the text, and inference – reading between the lines about why the author chose certain words or characteristics, using the text *Charlotte's Web* by E.B White. Thinking about stories from other people's perspectives is a hard skill but something we need to consider, especially as our children read and watch so many things online. It is really important that our children understand that NOT everything we hear or read is always TRUE!



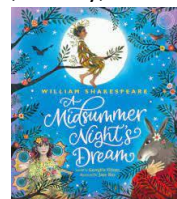
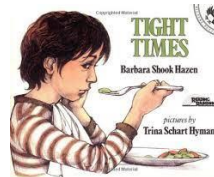
KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 2 set our Tudor houses on fire this week to recreate the Great Fire of London and see how quickly the fire spread.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week the children in **Year 5** have been continuing to learn more about *A Midsummer Night's Dream* in English. They have then written their end outcome of a diary entry from the point of view of one of the characters in the play. In Talking Points this week, they also learned all about debt, money, income and outgoings.



Year 6 had a very exciting visit recently from a "real" Viking. Sven appeared very dramatically in the classroom (one child nearly fell off her chair in surprise) brandishing a sword. His aim was to recruit Saxons and turn them into Viking warriors. He told us lots of information about Viking history in England. Sven taught Year 6 battle positions outside and were initiated by drinking from a skull. What a great introduction to our Viking themed work.
