Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the Y6 curriculum around preparing children for future adulthood we are excited to be able to offer our Year 6 pupils 2 additional trips this half term that are both designed around preparing them for adulthood and the responsibilities this involves.

The first visit is called Safety Zone and takes place at Ashfield Fire Station. Activities are provided by the following organisations:

- Nottinghamshire Fire & Rescue Service - Risky Room Fire Safety
- Nottinghamshire Police - Online Safety
- Nottinghamshire County Road Safety Team - Seatbelt Safety
- East Midlands Ambulance Service - CPR
- R.N.L.I - Water Safety
- British Transport Police - Rail Safety
- Dogs Trust - Dog Safety

This visit will take place Tuesday 27th June 2023. This is an afternoon visit so we will be leaving school at around 11:45am and returning around 3:00pm. As we are leaving before the usual lunchtime, your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them on this day that we will eat before leaving school.

The second visit is to Nottingham Trent University Clifton Campus. This is to learn about the University and what opportunities attending university when they are older can offer them. We will travel there by tram so that children become familiar with using public transport. This visit takes place on Tuesday 4th July. As we're using public transport it takes longer to travel so children need to be in school by 7:45am and we will aim to return to school by 4:00pm. Your child will need a packed lunch on this date.

Both visits are free themselves however we ask for a contribution towards the cost of the transport for each visit:

- Safety Zone = £5.50 per child
- Nottingham Trent University = £1.50 per child

If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them for both visits but please note a drink is not included in this so you will need to send your child to school with a drink that day. Please also ensure that your child comes to school in full school uniform with comfortable shoes and also brings their inhaler if they use one on these dates.

If you are able to support with either visit as a parent helper, please inform the office or your child's class teacher.
