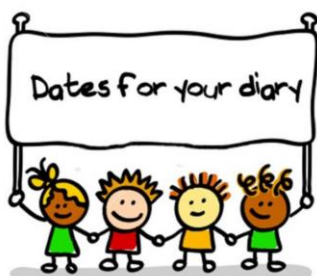

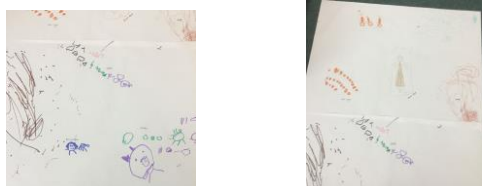


Primary and Nursery School

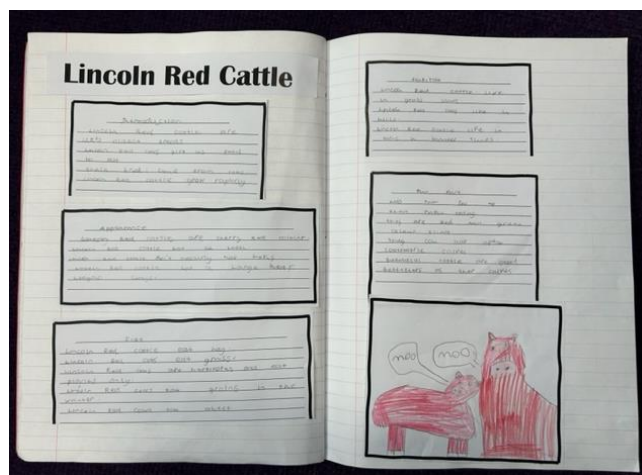

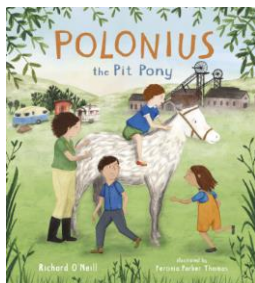
## KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

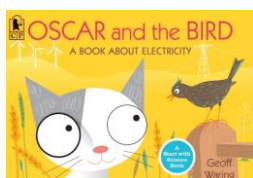
## KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

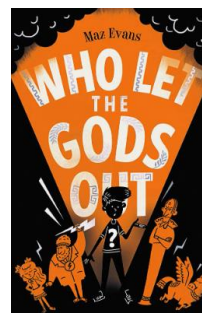
**Year 4** have continued their learning on electricity. We are in the middle of writing our own versions of the story Oscar and Bird. You can listen to the story here:

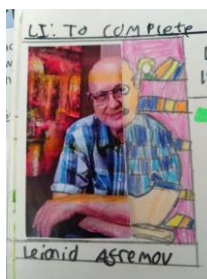


## KS2 (Years 5 and 6)
