It's also been Assessment Week! The children have done amazingly, working their socks off as always.

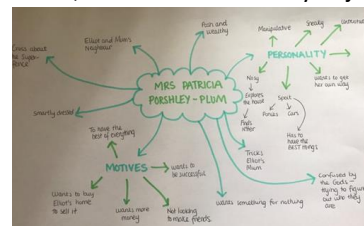
KS1 (Years 1 and 2)
