KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

This week **Year 2** have been busy finishing our carts, checking back that they met our criteria and testing them. In English we have been having fun writing shape poems about a farmyard animal. We then practiced and performed our poem.





KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

This week in our maths **Year 3** have been learning about perimeter and why we need to know this. Knowing what unit to measure in has also been a good discussion point too.

Year 4 have been testing out structures ready for when we are making electronic wire games at the end of our vehicle. The best bit was getting to eat the spare vertices of our structures!











KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

In Year 5, this week, we have been completing our termly assessments, all the children did a fantastic job with these and tried their best during all of the tests. Additionally, we have completed a full day of Art on Thursday where we completed a study about Ancient Greek art and look specially at the pottery created during the Ancient Greece civilization. The children painted a background before adding a detailed pattern in the style of a Greek vase. Also, we have used a design programme to create a template for a mars rover and thought about the different features this could have on it.

Even though many of our **Year 6** have been away at Walesby this week, the rest of the children in the year group have had some fun times too. They've completed some research on tallest buildings around the world and then transformed themselves into construction engineers using marshmallows and dried spaghetti. This is not as easy as it sounds - especially when the marshmallows seemed to disappear. They have helped out in F2, used glue guns in a craft project and made toasties.


Nursery Rhymes at Holgate
