KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have worked really hard on addition of 3-digit numbers this week. Understanding that we can exchange our ones into tens was a little tricky at first but taking it one step at a time has helped them to be successful. Setting out our sums as column addition has also helped us.

Year 4 have been learning about rounding numbers this week in maths. Understanding that we need to read and understand the value of all the numbers was tricky at first. Then knowing whether to round up or round down was the next step.

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

This week in PE the children in **Year 1** were able to use their body to make different shapes and letters. The children could direct other groups and explain how they were able to make the shapes and numbers.







KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week, **Y5** have started to explore rounding and have used a number line to support us. We can now round to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and are beginning to apply this to decimals and problems. Also this week, we have taken geranium cuttings and explored asexual reproduction. We have planted our cuttings and are now closely observing them.




