

EYFS

This week the children in F2 had a fantastic time at our Halloween Parents Forest School session. The loved the pumpkin hunt, Halloween activities and playing around in the woods. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank all the parents who attended and helped to make this session much more enjoyable for the children.







KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 1 have started our new science unit all about seasonal change. Some of the children have brought in Autumnal treasure they have found for us to take a closer look at. If you still have the bag at home to bring in with your treasure that you found, please bring them next week.



The children in Year 2 have settled back in really well after the half term break. They have started a new English unit based around a book called 'Dear Greenpeace'. In this book, Emily has a whale living in her garden pond, so she writes letters to Greenpeace for information about it. Each reply from Greenpeace is helpful, yet insistent that there can't possibly be a whale in her garden. The end outcome for this unit will be a letter, responding to Emily.

KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have started our measures unit in maths, learning about mm, cm and meters and to ALWAYS start at zero when using a ruler or tape measure. Here is a link as a reminder about the difference between length and height – something the children were getting a little bit confused with.

Comparing objects

We use certain words to compare the lengths and height of

- long, longer and longest
- short, shorter and shortest





Vhen comparing lengths or heights, make sure one end of ach object is lined up. You can then compare the other end to see which is longer.







KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week, **Year 5** have been exploring the difference between soluble and insoluble. To help with this, we investigated different materials such as oil, salt, cereal, coffee, tea leaves to find out whether or not they dissolve in the water.

Every class in school practises their handwriting with many children gaining their handwriting pen license. To warm up our fingers before starting, the children choose an exercise: fireworks, taking a bow, piano, pressing fingertips or fishing hook. Here is Year 6.
