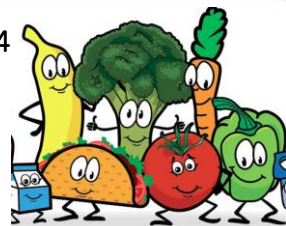

Primary and Nursery School

EYFS

In **F1** this week we were very excited when 2 monkeys visited us for our hook for our new vehicle 'Night and Day'. We learnt that one was called 'Night Monkey' and one was called 'Day Monkey'. They brought lots of different objects and some pictures for us to sort which belonged to each monkey. The nursery children did a fabulous job of sorting them into the correct hoops and thought of lots of reasons why they belonged to each monkey. We are really looking forward to learning about Night and Day further over the coming weeks.



KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 2 have become scientists this week and have been investigating the importance of hand washing. Ask your children about the investigation over the next few weeks to see if anything has begun to grow on the slices of bread.



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have started their new vehicle this week – 'Can I take your order?' We have talked and researched about the differences between being a vegetarian, a vegan and a flexitarian. We have also learnt about being persuasive – trying to convince and tempt someone to do something or make a change can be tricky.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week, **Year 5** have been exploring the artist called David McEown, who is a Canadian artist specialising in landscapes and wildlife such as penguins. We used the information and he artwork as inspiration to create an artist study page in our sketch book. In Maths, we have started to explore equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages. You could help your child by focusing on equivalent fractions and decimals for 25%, 75% and 50%. We have also attended some road safety workshops and remembered the rules about staying safe when we are out and about.

Last week **Year 6** rounded up their Viking learning with a cookery session baking Viking Oat Cakes. They followed the recipe, weighed ingredients and used the rubbing in method before forming small biscuit shapes. The smell of baking was fantastic and they really enjoyed themselves.



Year 6 have been looking at different types of poetry this week in their reading lessons. After identifying differently features, they worked in groups to perform to the rest of the class.
