Dear Parents/Carers,

In the Spring Term, Year 6 will be learning about plastic pollution and the environmental importance of recycling. As part of this project, we have organised a special trip to Veolia Materials Recovery Facility in Mansfield. The trip includes a tour of the facility to find out what happens there, how it works, and also a workshop led by staff at the facility.

The trip will go ahead on the following dates:

- 6AR - Tuesday 20th February
- 6AW - Monday 26th February

We will be leaving school at **8.00am**. We should be arriving back for approximately **13:00**. Your child will need to wear their full school uniform and will access lessons in school during the afternoon then return home at the usual end of the school day (3:10pm). They will have lunch at Veolia following their sessions before departing. Therefore, they will need a packed lunch for the day. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them but please note a drink is not included in this so you will need to send your child to school with a drink that day. Please also ensure that your child comes to school with their inhaler if they use one.

In order for the visit to take place, we require a voluntary contribution of £5.50 to cover the cost of the coach (as the visit itself is free of charge). Unfortunately, if insufficient funds are received by the deadline, we will have to cancel the visit. (School does not make a profit and all parental contributions will be used to pay for the trip).

Payments are to be made via Parentmail by Monday 29th January 2024. Consent must also be provided through Parentmail.
