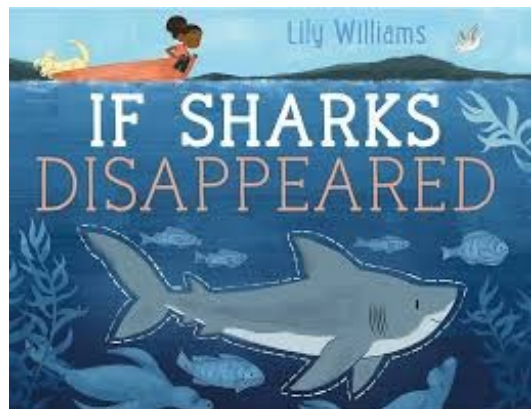

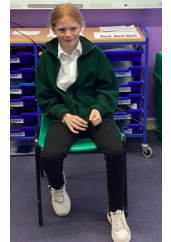

**We now have 209/300 Parents signed up for Boom Reader.**

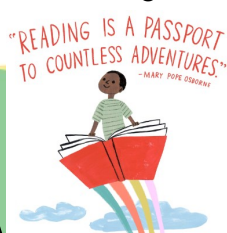
**Year 1 currently have the most parents signed up 83.7%, reception are close behind with 71%**
