Whole School Fundraising Activities

Over the course of the past year we have done many fundraising activities such as School Fairs, Ice cream, Tuck shop & Slushie sales, and bake sales. Through these activities, we have raised £12289. This income has been used to support the purchase of high-value resources that we otherwise would not have been able to access, such as individual iPads for children across Y3 & 4, and the purchase of our new Trim trail and picnic benches.



Educational Visits and Trips

We have taken the children on lots of educational and extracurricular visits. These have included residential to Walesby, Gulliver's Valley, and Bamburgh, along with educational visits to Eureka, Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Sherwood Forest, Brakenhurst Outdoor Education Centre, The National Holocaust Centre and lots more. Income received for visits is always used to pay for the children attending and often school will subsidise the visits or use grant funding to cover the costs.



Afterschool Clubs

Holgate has lots of varied afterschool activities for the children to participate in such as Choir, Arts and Crafts, Games, Sports and Film Clubs. The income received supports us to cover resources for the clubs and the remainder is used for whole-school fundraising. This year our afterschool club's profit was £4600 which has been used towards new and improved PE equipment - including a whole class archery set .
