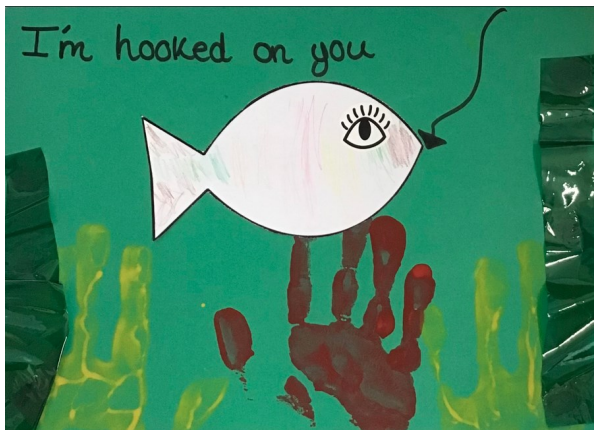

Years 1 and 2

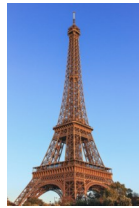

Holgate Heroes

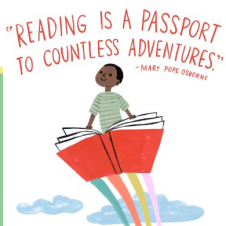

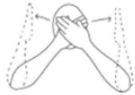
