**1/2EB** created some motivational cards during community action week to wish 6AW Good Luck in Year 7.



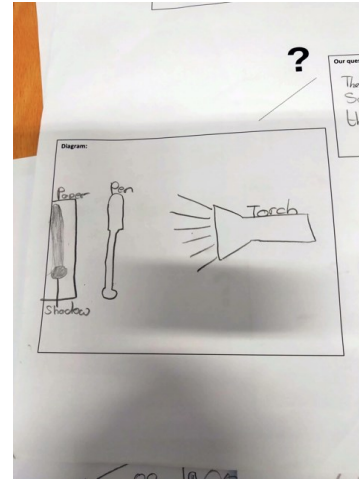

## Holgate Heroes

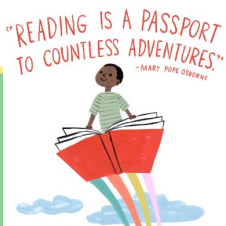

Reading is such an important life skill and as a school we actively encourage regular reading alone and with others. Using our Boom Reader Records we can see which children are recording their reading regularly.

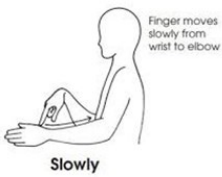
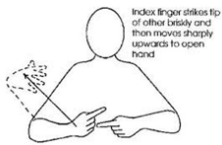
