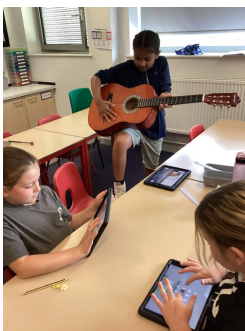
# HERE'S THE NEWS

## Holgate Heroes

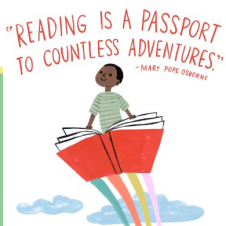

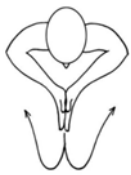
