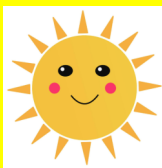

Holgate Heroes

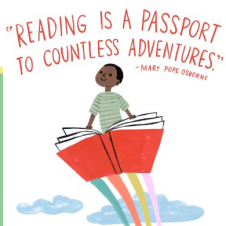
