- ✓ When films were first made, they had no sound. The first film made with sound was in 1927.
- ✓ The first ever cinema, built specifically to show motion-pictures, was the Nickelodeon in Pittsburgh in the year of 1905.
- ✓ Popcorn was not sold in cinemas initially as it was thought to be a food which was too noisy. Popcorn was introduced during a time called the Depression because it was cheap to buy and made the seller a lot of profit.
