- Stranger Danger.

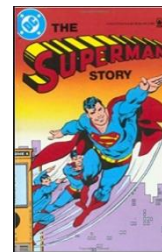
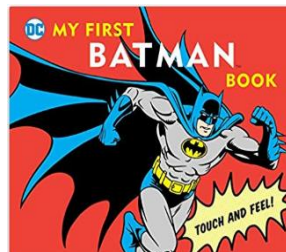
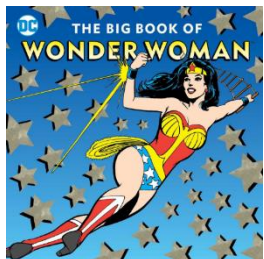

Vital Vocabulary
