

Sticky Knowledge

There are 4 main points on a compass North, East, South, West.

We use positional language to describe where things are and to give directions to move around a map e.g. forwards, backwards, up, down, left, right, under, North, South, East West.

There are 5 main groups of animals that have specific features – birds, mammals, fish amphibians and reptiles.

There are 3 different groups of feeders - omnivores, herbivores and carnivores.

Different animals live in different habitats – almost every place on Earth from the hottest desert to the coldest icepack is a habitat for some kind of animal or plant.

Most animals are covered with fur, feathers or scales and these are used to help group them into reptiles, mammals, fish, amphibians or birds.

omnivore	An animal that eats other animals or plants.
carnivore	An animal that eats other animals.
herbivore	An animal that eats plants.

amphibian	An animal spends its life in water and on land eg frogs toads newts.
reptile	A cold blooded animal that breathes air and usually has the skin covered with scales or bony plates.
bird	An animal that is warm blooded that has a backbone and lays eggs.
fish	A cold blooded animal that has skeletons inside their bodies and scales on their skin.
habitat	The home of an animal or plant.
Fact file	A collection of information about a particular subject or product.
detective	A person whose job is to investigate and solve problems.
poster	A large printed picture to give information.
