However, if there is **no other option for you** then please ensure you let us know either by phone, or on our Key Worker request email address <u>hpcovid19@holgateprimary.org</u> and we will provide one for you for the days you need during the 4 transition dates i.e. 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July. Your child/ren will obviously be able to attend their Transition Session too as part of this.

Thank you all as ever for everything you have done, and still are doing, to support your children with us at school in trying to make these unsettled times we are experiencing more positive, productive and happy for them.
