Primary and Nursery School

EYFS

Last week the children in Nursery all got to show off their "silly socks", before they danced their little feet away whilst doing their daily 'Wake and Shake'. They have then wriggled their toes into wellies ready for Forest School!



The children in F2 have been busy exploring their classroom and outdoor learning environment. They have settled well into Holgate and have been making new friends. The children have also all enjoyed their first Forest Schools sessions.

KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 had loads of fun keeping their feet busy dancing to Go Noodle and joining in with the Rock Steady live stream.

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 2 have been learning about the artist Piet Mondrian and how he used primary colours and blocks of colour. We used and mixed primary colours to create secondary colours on a colour wheel. We have practised drawing straight lines with a ruler, which is quite a tricky skill. We are using these skills to create our own pictures in this style using both paper and ICT. In our **English** lessons we have read The Selfish Crocodile and have been learning about using different determiners, adjectives and nouns to create more exciting sentences. We've had a lot of fun describing the jungle animals in the story. This week we are writing a fact file about Crocodiles and the children have loved learning some amazing facts. **Year 1** have been looking at different ark work made from natural objects. 1HO made salt dough hedgehogs and 1BG made salt dough tree faces. It was so much fun!



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Last week, 6IR and 6ED have been working tremendously hard and we are all loving being back in school. In Maths, we have been perfecting our rounding skills by rounding to the nearest million and exploring negative numbers. For our artwork, we are currently learning all about Gaudi. We have researched many facts and produced our own Gaudi fact files - Miss Roe was very impressed with our salamander drawing skills.



On Wednesday, the weather was miserable, so we did our PE lesson inside - which involved a high intensity 20-minute workout and Yoga. Lots of children thoroughly enjoyed the Yoga as it was a Cosmic Kids video where we got to listen to a story whilst perfecting our Yoga moves. Also, we have completed work on the Computers exploring how to use Microsoft Teams and use different features on a word document. We're looking forward to more exciting work next week.
