Dear parents/carers

Further to our letter last week on the use of Microsoft Teams, your child(ren) will now have received details of their logins. We are now able to start to launch homework via Microsoft Teams. This week's Teams homework will be set today (06/10/20) and will be accessible until next Tuesday, 13/10/2020.

We would love your feedback on how you have found accessing homework on Microsoft Teams.

This week's homework on Teams is **an English** challenge. Your child's challenge could have a chilli challenge:

#### Chilli Challenges:

Some of your child's work will be differentiated by Chilli Challenge. The children are familiar with this as it is used across school as a way to set activities pitched to each child's level. For a lesson set in this way, your child can choose which Chilli they would like to complete. They can either complete all of that chosen Chilli or do part of one Chilli and move onto a different Chilli to challenge themselves.



### Tongue Tingler

A Tongue Tingler activity tends to be very similar to that which you have already completed as part of the lesson and so you will be able to use exactly the same skills you have already practiced.



#### Nose Runner:

A Nose Runner activity will be quite similar to what you have already practiced but may have some trickier questions or require you to think about how to use your skills differently.



#### Eve Waterer:

For an Eye Waterer activity, you will need to use and apply the skills we have just learnt and practiced together to different concepts, taking learning to the next level.



#### The Beast:

This activity will require deeper thinking and may not be immediately obvious what you need to do. It will involve applying the skills we have just practiced but may also apply other skills that you have learnt in the past.




