






<u> Sketch a shoe – Art</u> <u>Challenge in Year 1 to Year 6</u>

EYFS

<u>F2</u> have been having a Science Week focused on looking at changes. We have spoken about how humans grow and change, how flowers change when they are placed in coloured water, how foods change when they decay and rot and how we can use vegetable and fruit waste to turn into compost. We have also investigated what happens to our teeth when we drink different liquids...we have done this by placing 'teeth' (hard boiled eggs) in water, coffee, vinegar and coke. We have left them and are waiting to see the results of our investigation!



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

This week,

In computing <u>Year 3</u> have been learning about online safety and what the internet is used for. They had some very interesting ideas - ordering food, online shopping, communication, and booking holidays (if only!)
