

EYFS

Last week our children made some delicious sandwiches using the cress that we grew in **Nursery**. The children made cheese sandwiches and put some cress on top. It was the first time that some children had tried cress before. The children practised spreading the cheese on the bread and cutting the cress. We still have lots of food growing and we are looking forward to eating some carrots and tomatoes from our outside garden.



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have enjoyed making a start to their Block Painting Project this week. We've created our food themed design and started to add string to cardboard to create the block. Next week, we're going to see our creations come to life as add colour and detail.





In maths, we have been learning all about money and practising our 'spending skills'. Adding and subtracting money as well as calculating change when purchasing items.

In English, we are working really hard on creating a piece of work to help children transition into their new classes for next year.

Year 4 have been getting arty this week creating Andy Warhol style prints for their Healthy athlete vehicle. They designed some images relating to Olympic sports, then made their own print by carving the image into polystyrene and printed a repeat pattern using bright and vibrant paints.



KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 1 completed a science investigation to find out what material would be a good window. We then got to make our houses and use the best material for the window. The trickiest bit was using our scissors to try and cut a hole in the card!



1HO have been learning about position and direction this week. They had a go at directing their friends from one cone to another by using the instructions forwards, backwards left and right. They also used their hands to know which was our left hand and right hand. They finished with a challenge of directing a friend through a cone maze without touching the cones.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Year 5 love football! The European Championships have been especially exciting, generating lots of heated conversations. On Monday, the children and staff didn't focus on the result of the final. They used the opportunity to talk about what the England team have achieved on and off the pitch, how young some of them are (what were you doing at 19?) and the courage needed to stand up in front of millions of people watching around the world. Haven't we all made a mistake at work? The children have heroes to look up to and be proud of. The classes focused on resilience, composure and determination to dream big. 
