KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

What a 'magical' wander <u>Year 3</u> had this week. To support our English work on extending our sentences. We went for a walk along the winding, bark path, towards the large Oak tree and stood beneath the sun-soaked glistening branches. Prepositions tell us where something is happening or give direction e.g. beside, between, among, beneath, towards. Any help at home using these words in conversation would be a great help for your child. Year 3 were incredibly excited to discover 'a magical' world of 'little' people who love anything that glitters or shines. We hope that this mini world will inspire them to use more creative and expressive writing next week when they write a set of instructions for the teachers to discover their own 'magical place'.

In <u>Year 4</u> this week, we have started our new vehicle 'Marvelous Museum'. We have really enjoyed learning about the start of the Roman invasion of Britain and have created some brilliant models of and posters about Hadrian's wall, these will be on display at our own museum! Also, we've been testing our French knowledge by starting a unit of work about animals. We learnt the names of 6 different animals in French, try asking your children if they can remember any of these.

KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

It has been incredibly busy in <u>Year 5</u> over the last few days and we can't believe how quickly the week has whizzed by.

In English, we have been learning all about relative clauses and how to use these in our writing. Maybe you could ask our Year 5 children to write some sentences including relative clauses home for you to see our new skills and send these to our class emails.

In Vehicle, we have discovered that the use of land changed during the war and the people were encouraged to 'dig for victory' as the government were worried about a food shortage.

In Maths, we have continued to develop our place value knowledge and we can now order and compare numbers up to 1,000,000.

What a busy week we've had! Miss Roe and Miss Davies:)

Year 6 have been discussing the difference between an 'opinion' and 'fact'. Sarah said, "A fact is something that is definitely true, an opinion is what someone thinks." We posed the question, "Can you argue someone's opinion?" The children weren't quite sure so Mrs Hicklin drew a '6' on a piece
