#### **EYFS**

This half term the children have joined us in some fantastic after school club activities. This week we would like to share some photos from our running club. We have worked on our speed to improve our stamina. The children were sprinting over a distance and then returning jogging back to recover. We talked as a group, and we are going to work towards a 'junior Parkrun' which is held on a Sunday at Titchfield park. I shared my own experience with the children and told that in my own Primary school I saw a picture of my head teacher completing the Robin Hood Marathon. I shared with the children that I will be once again completing the half marathon this Sunday. I know we have a few parents completing as well and wish them luck and hope to see them. #### KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

<u>Year 3</u> have worked hard this week in English to draw and plan their story map to support them in writing their own set of instructions to find a magical place.

They have used their knowledge of prepositions (where something is or when it is happening) to add more detail for the reader.

They have used imperative verbs, e.g. walk, follow, turn to ensure the directions are clear.

They have also improved their sentence starters too, using richer vocabulary, e.g. beneath, beside or among. The children were very kind and complimented each other on their work.

Here is some of their feedback to one another:

- "It was great to look at each other's story maps."
- "I told her she had drawn a really good map."
- "I liked how he had included labels on the map."
- "It was nice to look at each other's and see what they had drawn on their map."

Well done Year 3 you have made a GREAT start in KS2!
