This week in <u>Nursery</u> during our child-initiated time we have been exploring different ways to paint and different textures. We have explored what happens to ice when we hold it and how to use marbles to create works of art. We have been working hard with our fine motor skills as well as building our vocabulary with some new words to describe how things feel.







This week in <u>F2</u> we have had lots of fun exploring ice as part of our Arctic theme. We were very excited to rescue the people who were trapped inside and tried to free them by using spoons to chip away at the ice. We also watched how the ice melted slowly and thought that the ice felt cold, wet and icy.

KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week, <u>Year 5</u> went on our trip to Perlethorpe where we were met by Sergeant Curtis. During the day, we experienced what life would have been like for an evacuee moving to the countryside and what roles they'd have been expected to do. We learnt the history of WW2 - Miss Roe and Miss Davies were incredibly impressed with how much we had remembered from our Vehicle lessons. Another activity involved exploring suitcases from people who had been evacuated and trying to work out who they belonged to - look out for photos of us dressed up on Facebook. In the afternoon, we went to see what an Anderson shelter was and practised our orienteering skills outdoors. The children's behaviour was fantastic and a big thank you to

the parent volunteers, who came along to support.

Year 6 have been researching Antonio Gaudi. He was a Spanish architect who used mosaic patterns in his buildings. His most famous buildings can be found in Barcelona. The children will be making a fact file and they have been busy designing their own mosaic patterns.
