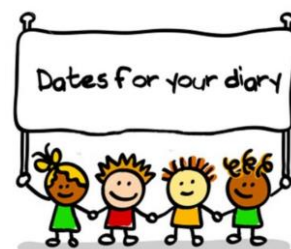

KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

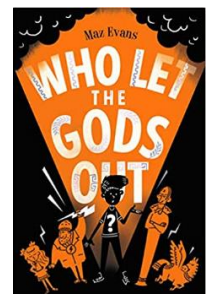

Trying to make our questions clear and easy to understand was tricky, so we are encouraging the children to keep reading their work, checking it makes sense. As we start to create our end outcome of a game all about the prehistoric age, we need to make sure our questions are interesting, family friendly and FUN!

In **Year 4** this week, we have been working hard in our Maths and English sessions. We have been writing our own stories about how hero and villain are battling it out in someone's digestive system. The highlight of the week was the car wash we completed on Friday. This was a roaring success and the staff and children of Year 4 would like to say a massive thank you to everyone who supported the event.
