EYFS

What a fantastic second week we have had in F2. We have been exploring our new learning and taken a visit to our forest school areas. The children have been learning about Autumn and how the leaves on the trees are starting to change colour. We explored some new activities and even met the ducks that we keep at school. We shared that one of our ducks had laid an egg and that she can lay an egg each day. We looked at her nest area and we even fed and stroked the ducks. We have been learning some more new sounds in our phonics and have been blending our sounds to make word. We have been super proud at how well the children have been concentrating and trying hard with their learning. We have continued to explore learning in different ways with the children and have explored how music makes us feel. When we come in after dinner, we listen to some soothing music to make us ready for the afternoon. During our music lesson this week we shared a song called 'Happy' by Pharrel Williams and some of the children loved the music and were up dancing around. We then listened to a new song singing 1,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive and joined in together.







KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

This week in maths **Year 3** have been trying hard to solve how numbers can jump up or down in different amounts, e.g. 10's, 50's or 100's. Starting at any three digit number, we have had to count up or count backwards to solve how many more or how many less we need, e.g. 125, 135, 145. We have also had to learn two new words – ascending and descending. Maybe you could practice this skill with your child – here is a link to ICT games.

This week, **Year 4** have been working really hard learning all about rounding in Maths. Overall, they've done brilliantly and showing Mr Rathe and Miss Wood what cracking mathematicians we have in Year 4. We have also been learning about when the Romans lived and when they invaded Britain. The children have loved acting out their work and some of their recall in each lesson has been great.





KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

In **1RW**, we have been thinking about ways to remember the Queen. We designed and painted our own royal stamps and discussed her life. We also spent time discussing the celebrations we had in school for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.



Year 2 have loved learning about the worlds 5 oceans and 7 continents in their vehicle lessons this week!



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Year 5 have continued their great start to the new school year. This week, we have enjoyed our exciting PE sessions. 5DG went swimming for the first time this year and 5GS enjoyed 2 sessions on tag rugby and badminton. In our vehicle sessions, we continued our learning about World War 2, the causes of this and the important role women played during the war. This has made us even more excited for our trip to Perlethorpe on Friday.

Wow! What a week **Year 6** have had! It started with an amazing (but soggy) trip to Alton Towers. We spent the entire day whizzing around on rollercoasters experiencing drops, twists and big loops - it was such fun! Later in the week, we played netball in the glorious sunshine and have worked extremely hard in our lessons.
