


This week **F2** we have been learning about different types of houses and what kind we live in. We have looked at the different features of houses and even made our own!

KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

It's been another exciting week in **Year 5**! We have completed a wide range of different tasks and activities and this has included our end outcome writing about Rose Blanche. We wrote a first-person narrative that included all the key events that occur in Rose Blanche. Furthermore, on Friday last week, we had the first session of a new workshop that we will be working on for the next 3 weeks called the GREAT project. In this we will be learning all about what makes a relationship healthy and what can make them unhealthy. Also, **5GS** are looking forward to our Library visit next Thursday and are exciting to swap books or take new ones out.

Year 6 have been studying Light in science. They've completed many investigations eg Does light travel in straight lines? Their latest learning objective was to investigate whether objects cast the same shape shadow. Yr 6 made a shadow puppet and used torches to check their predictions. They had lots of fun, whilst learning.



Nursery Rhymes at Holgate




In EYFS and Key Stage 1, the children will be having a weekly nursery rhyme focus.
