KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week, the children did an artist study in **Year 5** and looked at World War 2 artist John Piper. John Piper was particularly famous for painting pictures of Coventry Cathedral after it had been bombed by the Germans. The children tried to recreate a watercolour painting in the style of John Piper.
