



What a great start back to Autumn 2 **Year 3** have had this week. We have started our new PE unit – Badminton and hockey. In hockey - It was great to see the children working independently to score points as they dribbled the ball through the different sized goals. Then working collectively as a team they were very supportive dribbling, passing and weaving their way through the cones. Great work Year 3!





KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

The children of **Year 5** have returned to school with enthusiasm and energy after the half term. We have started lots of new topics including a new English book called The Invisible by Tom Percival, which is a moving, powerful story that shines a light on those who feel invisible in our world - and shows us that we ALL belong. Next week, the children are going to be writing two comparative setting descriptions from the book - one will be of a happy place and the other is an unhappy place.

Year 6 have finished their vehicle work on rollercoasters now. Their last exciting piece of work was to work in groups to produce a "pitch" which was filmed by Miss Roe and could be sent to Alton Towers to interest them in ideas for a new rollercoaster ride. In their presentation, they had to concentrate on eye contact, voice expression, confidence and

hand gestures. From the photos, you can see some great discussion and team work. Miss Roe reports that all the filming was done in 'one take'. Obviously a few budding actors in the making.
