## Time 2 Chat:

For this weeks time to talk we would like you to focus on story telling with your child and in particular using the language we find in stories that may help with oral retelling.

Grab an empty jar from your kitchen and some torn up pieces of paper. On each small piece of paper write a random word or phrase. This could be anything, such as cat, princess or a phrase from a story eg "I will huff and I will puff". Put all the torn up pieces of paper inside the jar. Then take turns to take out a piece of paper. Whatever the word is on that paper, that person must tell a story using that word or phrase. If your child gets stuck, you can use prompts, such as:

"What does your character see or hear?"
"Who else is there?"

"What does the place look like?"

Be as creative as you like. You could even have a go at making up a silly story to make each other laugh (3)

#### **EYFS**




# **Nursery Rhymes at Holgate**
