
Do you think you will see any life? If so what may you see? Will you land on any planets? What might they be like? Will there be anything on them?

In **F2** this week we worked together to make our own castle!! We even have a working drawbridge!!






KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

For this vehicle, we are asking for donation of food and other items, which we can pass on to a local homeless charity. A Parentail was sent out about this last week and we have already started to receive donations. Thank you to everyone who has donated so far!

As part of our RE topic this term, **Year 6** have been looking at some of the different faiths in our communities. We have found out information about the differences in religions, that are followed in Hucknall and Mansfield, by completing and understanding data in bar charts. The children have enjoyed discussing what it means to be part of a diverse community and how sharing different ideas, faiths, food, traditions, language skills can promote a more respectful and tolerant society.












Nursery Rhymes at Holgate
