
It is beginning to look a lot like Christmas in **Nursery!** We had so much fun decorating our Christmas tree and spoke about all the things we like to do at Christmas time.



KS1 (Years 1 and 2)


This week **Year 2** have been working REALLY hard to finish our non-chronological reports on sharks. I am sure you will agree, they look amazing!
