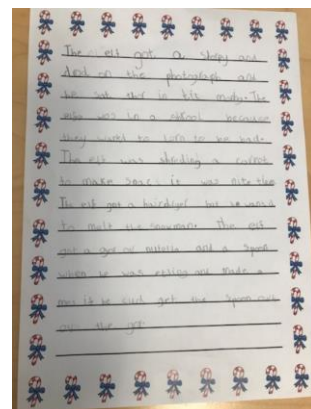
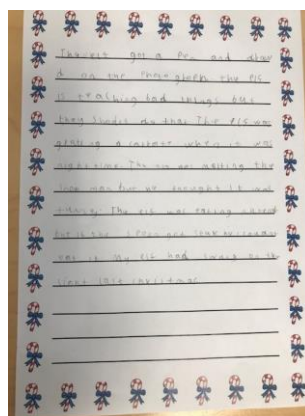

KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week in **Year 5**, we have been completing our Gift of Giving vehicle. The children and staff of Year 5 would like to say a massive thank you to everyone who contributed towards our donation for the homeless charity, The Friary. Because of these wonderful donations, we were able to send the CEO of the charity back to the centre with a van full of clothes, food and other items that will help people in need. Mr. Talbot, the CEO of the charity, also delivered a talk to the children about why people become homeless and how The Friary support people to get back on track.



Year 6 have been very busy (almost puffing and panting in fact) in science recently. We have been learning about our blood circulation. The children devised an investigation to find out if there was a connection between exercise and raised pulse rates. It was certainly tricky finding our pulses to begin with but lots of fun. Year 6 decided to time their pulse rates after a minute of vigorous exercise e.g. jogging, star jumps etc and recorded their findings on a graph. Their pulse rate was then checked again after a few minutes rest.

Don't forget to read as often as you can and record this in your child's reading diary too!

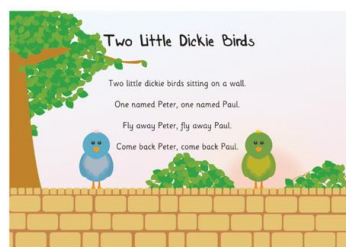
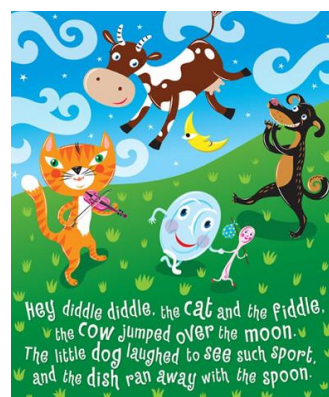
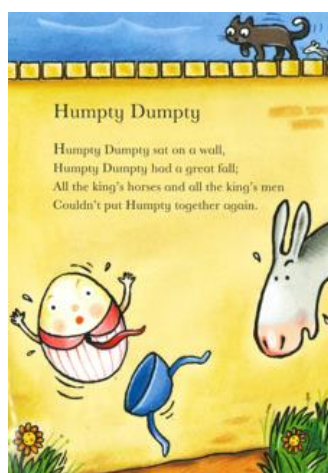
Nursery Rhymes at Holgate
